In supersession of this office notification No. PWPD/DDWHL/O/251125/0263 dated 25.11.2025, the Partridge Hunting Season 2025-26 notification is hereby revised and issued with immediate effect.

In order to promote sport hunting and to provide fair opportunities to legal hunters & to avert the hunting pressure on species of a particular area, Partridge hunting shall be carried out only on Sundays on specified dates and hunting grounds of Punjab as per the following details and instructions:-

Following provisions of Punjab Wildlife (Protection, Preservation, Conservation & Management) Act 1974 (Amended 2025) / Rules framed thereunder and Punjab Protected Areas Act 2020 (Amended 2025) / Rules framed thereunder shall be strictly followed:-

- i. Hunting shall only be permissible on Sunday(s).
- ii. Hunting shall only be allowed with licensed weapons and a valid shooting license.
- iii. Hunting in areas mentioned under Part-III and Part-IV & and Part-V shall be permissible under Permits and Special Permits respectively, issued under the relevant Rules by the issuing authorities as mentioned in the above Table.
- iv. The dates of the Partridge hunting season 2025-26 shall be as follows:
 - A. For Part I, III, IV and V the hunting season shall be from **14th December till 15th of February** on specified dates on permits/special permits issued manually.
 - B. For Part II the hunting season shall commence from **1st of December till 15th of February** through permits issued from Wildlife PASS.
- v. For Cholistan PWR hunting will commence from **26th of January 2026 till 15th of February 2026**.
- vi. Auction for permits mentioned in Part-I and Part-III will be held on 8th of December 2025 and for the next three consecutive days in case the permits are available, at the office of Deputy Chief Wildlife Ranger Salt Range, Kallar Kahar, and for Part IV auction will be held on 5th December, 2025 and for the next three consecutive days at Safari Zoo, Lahore.
- vii. Bag limit for Black and Grey partridges will be as mentioned in Schedule-I of the Punjab Wildlife (Protection, Preservation, Conservation & Management) Act 1974 (Amended 2025).
- viii. Use of automatic or service weapons or ammunition used by the Armed Forces of Pakistan, the Police Force, or any other Force shall be prohibited for Similarly, use of PCP, CO2 Airguns / Silenced Airguns shall also be prohibited in this respect.
- ix. Use of drones, electronic/battery-operated gadgets, etc., during hunting is strictly prohibited.
- x. Only the gun dogs with a valid possession license shall be used for partridge hunting while seated/standing in a vehicle i.e. Jeeping is prohibited.
- xi. Hawking is only allowed under a valid possession license of Hawk along with a valid shooting permit.
- xii. No party engaged in shooting shall comprise more than three Guns, and the number of beaters shall not exceed ten.

- xiii. For hunting in CBCs mentioned under Part-III, the President of the respective CBC shall submit requests for issuance of hunting permits to the Chief Wildlife Ranger along with particulars of the hunter, date of hunting expedition, etc.
- xiv. All the proceeds accrued from the auction/issuance of permits in hunting grounds mentioned under **Part-I, Part-III and Part-IV** will be deposited in the Board Fund and shall be prospectively dealt in accordance with the provisions of the Punjab Community Based Conservancy Rules, 2023.
- xv. No hunting is allowed in Protected Areas and their one-km radius, except Public Wildlife Reserves as mentioned under Part-IV, or Community Based Conservancies, other than those mentioned at Part-III above, and near/around defense installations etc.
- xvi. During Partridge's hunting season, Hare hunting on Sundays is only allowed to Hunters who are in possession of a valid Partridge shooting permit and a shooting license.
- xvii. The hunting in Private Wildlife Reserves will be permissible only after the due consent of the concerned owner of the Private Wildlife Reserve.
- xviii. The Owners of Private Wildlife Reserves shall inform the department about hunting expeditions and share carbon copies of the hunting Permits to the Department prior of hunting day.
- xix. The hunting shall be carried out under the supervision of the Chief Wildlife Rangers through concerned Wildlife Rangers, and necessary volunteers from the communities may be engaged for carrying out necessary facilitation in the local areas.
- xx. All areas other than hunting grounds as mentioned under Column-2 (district), read with Column-4 (extent) of each district shall be treated as closed for hunting, and any violation in such areas will be construed as an offence and shall be dealt with as per law.
- xxi. The status of open/closed tehsils or areas mentioned in the table above shall have no bearing on, nor cause any change in the status of open/closed Private Wildlife Reserve or Community Based Conservancies given under Part-II and IV above.
- xxii. The hunters are urged to contact the respective district office for the collection of geo-referenced GIS-based shape files of the respective hunting ground to avoid any intricacy and trespassing of boundaries, etc. The In-Charge of districts and divisional offices under the Directorate General of Wildlife & Parks, Punjab shall be the focal person in this respect.
