OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION UPSCALING OF GREEN PAKISTAN PROGRAMME (2ND REVISION)

The undersigned is directed to refer subject project of Ministry of Climate Change and Environmental Coordination received through Intelligent Project Automation System (iPAS) on 29-03-2024 and to say that the project was considered by the Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (ECNEC) in its meeting held on 07-08-2025. The forum took following decision vide Case No. ECNEC-31/03/2025:

"The Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (ECNEC) considered the summary dated 27th June, 2025 submitted by the Ministry of Planning, Development and Special Initiatives regarding **"Upscaling of Green Pakistan Programme (Revised)"** and approved the proposals contained at para-15 of the summary.

II. The ECNEC further directed the Ministry of Climate Change and Environmental Coordination to provide the necessary data related to the project to the Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Division."

Para-15 of the summary is reproduced below:

The project is placed before ECNEC for consideration at the revised cost of Rs 122.146 billion without FEC component on 50:50 sharing basis from PSDP and provincial share.

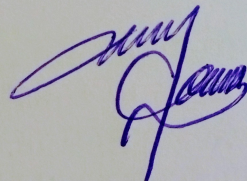

5. The receipt of this O.M may kindly be acknowledged.



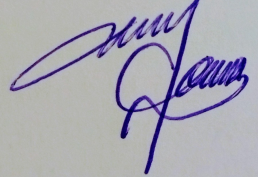
